

STAR




#### From Head to Toe

Book Review: Beautiful collage illustrations are easy for little tots to see and repeat the action, while they enjoy the essence of reading.






Early Literacy Activity

Learning to print the letters needs to be approached in a stepwise manner by starting with the basic units – strokes that make up the letters and moving on to combining these units to form letters. Recap of all strokes and letters learnt was done through various activities which the little tots enjoyed thoroughly moving ahead and improvising writing skills.





Teaching children about numbers and shapes is a great way to give them some vocabulary for describing the world around them. This opens up new and exciting avenues for verbal communication. As children learn to identify shapes, they can sort and classify objects around them based on these attributes. 'Circle' and Numbers 1, 2 and 3 were introduced through various tasks and assignments.

All About Me - An All About Me theme is a celebration of each student, their abilities and the unique characteristics that make them who they are. The children enjoyed doing all the activities related to the topic and bringing to the fore their uniqueness through their well-articulated presentations.





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Art and craft activities like marble painting and sponge painting help the toddlers develop fine motor skills and sensory skills. Students enjoyed experimenting and exploring sponge painting while making a card for their dad to wish them Happy Father's Day. A sense of achievement and pride adorned their face when they carried the card to gift their dad.

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Sports give a child the chance to learn about being part of a team, winning well and bouncing back from a loss. Sports also teaches children about how important it is to work hard, even if this doesn't always mean winning. It is important to remember that the attitude and behaviour taught to children in sports carry over to adult life. Our students have a well planned sports sessions in their schedule which caters to playing, participating and acknowledging success of self and others. We build the sportsmanship spirit very early.



Music and Movement

Music and movement help children develop skills such as cognitive growth, problemsolving, self-expression and social development. A child's learning is incomplete without music and movement in early childhood education. Hence our learning environment is loaded with these.




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Beginning at an early age, Montessori nurtures order, concentration, and independence. Intentional classroom design, materials, and daily routines support the student's ability to educate one's self, and to think about what one is learning. Exercises of practical life like rolling a mat, sorting objects with tongs and how to carry sharp objects was introduced to children. Developing life skills at an early stage enhances strong foundation for the future.

Theme: Eric Carle's Birthday Participants: Students of Kindergarten Date: 26-06-2023




