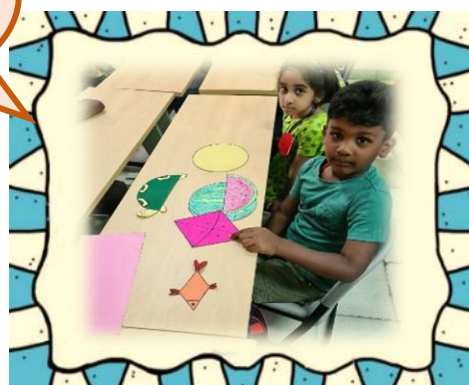


Topic: Slanting line

Learning to print the letters needs to be approached in a stepwise manner by starting with the letter strokes that make up the letters and moving on to combining these strokes to form letters. An important aspect of learning is the increasingly strong and automatic association between the sound of the letter (phoneme) and the shape of the letter (grapheme).

Recap of strokes, capital A to Z, Print a to z and Introduction to cursive strokes is done.

Early Numeracy

Number sense is important for our young math learners because it promotes confidence and encourages flexible thinking. It allows children to create a relationship with numbers and be able to talk about math as a language. Our little tots were introduced to numbers and number sequencing. Number sequencing is an important readiness skill and this concept helps children learn to recognize pattern that make their world more understandable and predictable.

Self-introduction for kids is an important skill for a number of reasons: It develops their confidence when meeting people in a new environment. Name play in school also has many cognitive benefits which include the ideals that recognizing one's name helps them feel important. All about me is a celebration of each student including their abilities and their unique characteristics which makes them who they are. As part of this theme, activities like – My birthday, Birthday cake and mystery bag activity were done.



Art and Craft

Art and craft activities give kids a sense of achievement and allow them to take pride in their work which builds confidence. Kids get to try new things and also develop their “self-regulation skills” (e.g., when waiting for paint or glue to dry). Our little tots made cards wishing their father’s-on-Father’s Day. Sports give a child the chance to learn about being part of a team, winning well and bouncing back from a loss. Sports also teaches children about how important it is to work hard, even if this doesn’t always mean winning. It is important to remember that the attitude and behaviour taught to children in sports carry over to adult life. Music and Movement

Music and movement help children develop skills such as cognitive growth, problem-solving, self-expression and social development. A child's learning is incomplete without music and movement in early childhood education. Hence our learning environment is loaded with these.



Montessori

Beginning at an early age, Montessori nurtures order, concentration, and independence. Intentional classroom design, materials, and daily routines support the student's ability to educate one's self, and to think about what one is learning. Exercises of practical life like rolling a mat, sorting objects with tongs and how to carry sharp objects was introduced to children. Developing life skills at an early stage enhances strong foundation for the future.



Kannada

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Letter-'a' and 'aa'

Learning a new language pushes a brain to get familiar with new grammar and vocabulary rules. It allows us to train memory to remember new words, make connections between them, and use them in contextual situations. Our little tots were introduced to the new language Kannada, who learned to introduce themselves in Kannada, They learnt the first two letters in the varnamala 'a', 'aa', along with names of different rooms in the house.

The event was celebrated to make students understand the important role their dads play in their life, and also to make them aware of the efforts the male parent takes in fulfilling their roles and responsibilities towards the family. 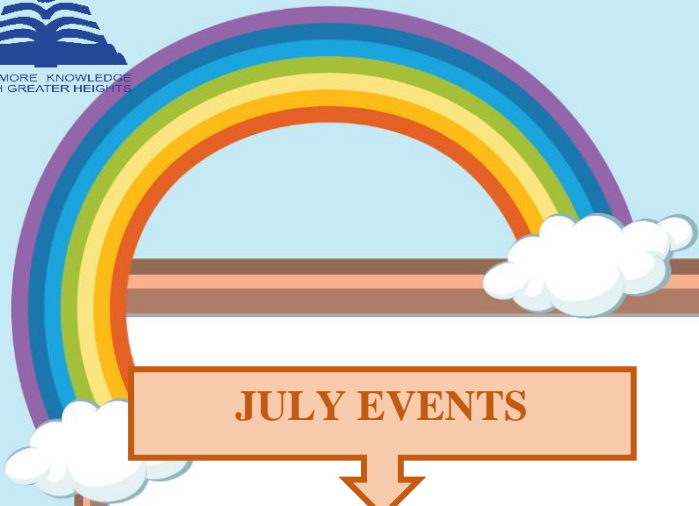
Eric Carle's Birthday

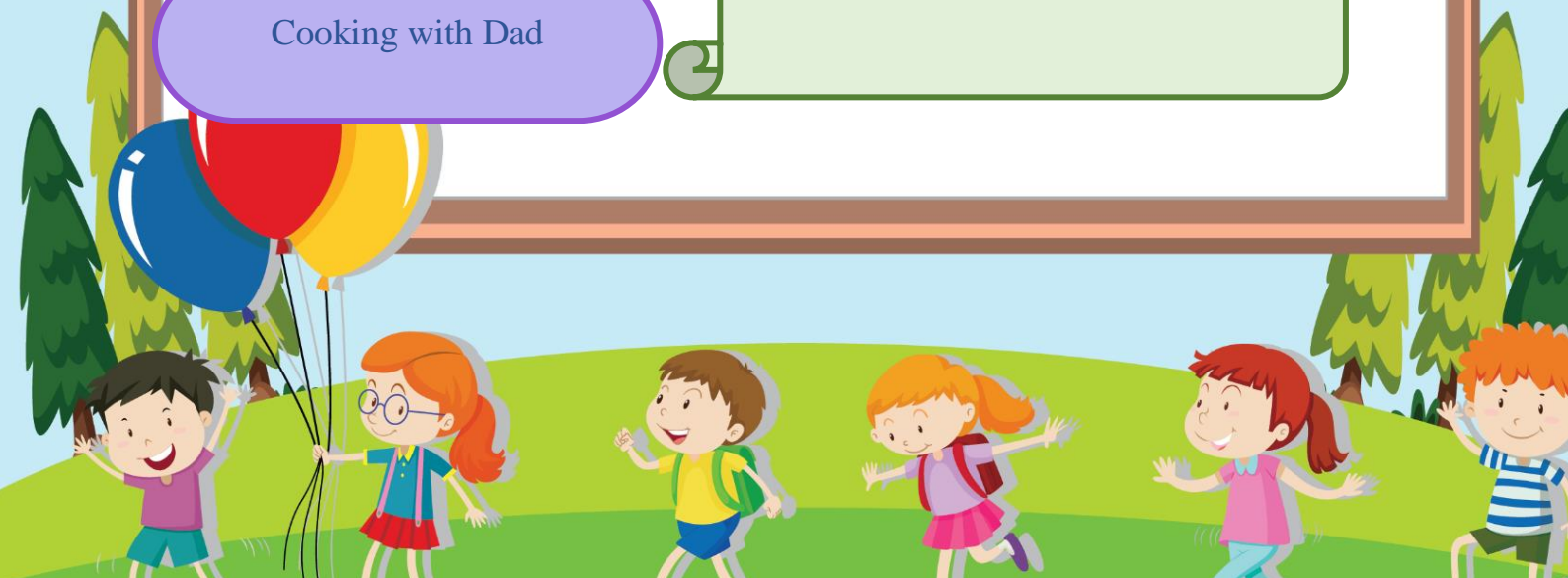
