LAR – Phonics: Children learnt new words and sounds which laid emphasis on new high frequency words. A game of Hopscotch helped reinforce the sound of letters and that did a great job. The impact was for all to see.

Nouns: Children explored the concept of nouns through an activity. The need to capatilize the first letter for proper nouns and use lower case for common nouns was well learnt. The excitement of the children was palpable when it was their turn to answer.







Mathematics

Math: Numbers play an important role in our lives. Children recapitulated these through a surfcit of activities. They were provided with number flash cards and manipulatives to identify the numbers and relate them with the number value. The counting activity kept all the students alert as focus and concentration was the key to the right answer.



EVS: Me and My Body- Students discussed about their likes, dislikes and their hobbies. They acknowledged that every individual is unique and this must be celebrated. Through simple experiments children learnt about sense organs and their functions . The importance of taking care of their body was discussed. Students learnt the need to remain healthy and strong, take care of themselves by avoiding junk food and eating healthy.

My Family : Students also learnt about Nuclear and Extended families. They shared happy moments spent with their family. The roles and responsibility of each family member was discussed. In the Family Tree activity, students drew pictures of their family members as well as those of extended family members.

Music and Movement

Children in these session introduced to Music and movement. Children were taught the Vocal warm up exercise with short and long notes - the solfege with hand signs. Movement meant learning the parts of the body through trending songs.

Art and Craft

Students traced the picture of a horse and coloured the horse and cowboy. Using their imagination they also drew the sun , birds , butterflies in the background. Indeed the work of art was a masterpiece, each in their own way.





Games help to develop concentration, motor skills and hand eye coordination. For the physical development of children various games like 'Fire in the Mountain', Jumping and hopping basic throw ball techniques were sessioned- Introduction of asanas for International Yoga Day was done.

This activity was a reflection for students to understand the importance of having bird feeders at homes as they are sources of food and water. With time there has been a dearth of nesting places and hence birds do not find enough food and water in city limits. Students made exquisite bird feeders. Bird feeders can provide birds a dependable supply of food and water and act as organic food suppliers to keep them well fed and thriving. Students enjoyed decorating their bird feeder and planned for vintage spaces where these would be placed in their homes. Students learnt the fact that the use of a bird feeder depends upon its placement and the kinds of food that we offer. 














Robot Making Competition : 23-6-2023


Eid Special Assembly: Conducted on 27-6-2023




The students dressed in their finery played their roles to perfection and added to the festive mode.
