<u>Nouns</u> – Teaching young children the way nouns are used in sentences is incredibly important which helps them to be better readers and make sentences. Students learnt to identify the naming words around them. They learnt that all naming words are nouns. They learnt nouns are names of people, places, animals and things through various activities like – The Noun Hunt and The Noun Jar during which they had to read and identify if the word was a common noun or a proper noun.

<u>One and Many</u> – Students learnt about Singular and Plural words through many hands on activites where they had seggregated words as to one and many. Chidren also created a Plural tree by sticking leaf shaped cutouts with plural forms of nouns written on them. They also learnt about articles and enjoyed the flower activity where they had to write naming words related to the article which was in the middle of the flower.



Mathematics

In Math, Addition Stories are word problems, where an addition sum is laid out in sentences for children to decipher and solve. The Students of Grade 1 deepened their knowledge of Addition Stories with the use of Manipulatives in their classroom. They got different fruits and vegetables to the class and created a scene of a market to understand and relate the scene to the real life situation. The students added them and explained the sum in the form of a story to the whole class. Every child had an opportunity to be a part of this activity and explore more on the topic in a fun filled way. The students mentioned the number of fruits and vegetables and recorded the same in their classwork notebooks. This activity helped develop an understanding and build competency with addition and mental math skills.









<u>Celebrations</u>: Students of grade 1 learnt in depth about the various festivals in India by writing an essay on the cultural and historical importance of a religious festival and a national festival. They shared these with their peers in class and learnt about the diversity of our country. They enjoyed the mystery box activity where a group of students had to take out word cards from the box and guess the festival related to it.

Fun Time: Interactive Activity – IN or OUT game: - The teacher displayed pictures of various indoor and outdoor games. Students were given IN and OUT cards, and they participated by holding up the correct card – IN for indoor and OUT for outdoor games. The lesson was summed up with a collage on indoor and outdoor games wher the students brought cutouts of pictures of any games. The students also played games in the class like blindfold, stone paper sicorss, X O X games in class when they learnt about recreation.

Art and Craft

Children learnt vocal warm ups - breathing exercise, solfege - long & short notes, low and high pitch. They learnt melody of songs and sang in rhythm and pitch. The songs learnt are Sa, Re, Ga, Ma Scale song. If You're Happy and you know it. God Loves me. Naani Teri Morani. Recap of School Prayer, School Anthem & National Anthem as done. Colouring regularly can boost children's sense of accomplishments and pride in themselves. Students enjoy colouring in the play with art book. Students learnt to design letters of their choice in their drawing book. They learnt the vibgyor colours. They also learnt the craft of tearing and pasting crepe paper.



Students used the cones to do the zig- zac race. They were able to walk zigzag between the cones They used movement concepts and developed body control. They could also work on balance and coordination. Teacher demonstrates on how to jump over the hurdle and students practice hurdle race this helped in balancing, strength and coordination.





English Month Activities



My Mini Dictionary Activity - Sight words help build confidence in young readers. Once children know sight words, they only need to slow down their reading to focus on decoding new, challenging words. This activity helped the students to identify and write simple sight words and create a sight word dictionary which will help them in their future classes. They can always refer this sight word dictionary in their class whenever they have to write/frame sentences on their own. Students actively took part in the activity and created lovely mini dictionaries. They decorated the cover page of the booklet and wrote many sight words in it. They also helped/ shared and exchanged their sight words with friends.

This competition was a part of the English Month where the students had to sing/recite a rhyme with a twist. The main objective was to encourage creativity and language skills through a fun and interactive rhyming competition. Students showed impressive creativity and thinking in incorporating the twist to the rhyme. The students were judged on the basis of Creativity, Rhyming Accuracy, Confidence, and Overall Performance. 







