Math: Numbers play an important role in our lives. Children recapitulated these through a surfeit of activities. They were provided with number flash cards and manipulatives to identify the numbers and relate them with the number value. The counting activity kept all the students alert as focus and concentration was the key to the right answer.

Through simple experiments children learnt about sense organs and their functions. The importance of taking care of their body was discussed.
