<u>Pronouns</u> - The topic of pronouns was introduced in grade 1 through a fun activity, where the students had to move towards the correct Pronoun Pla Card (he, she and It) when the teacher calls out a noun. Like Rohan - he, Aalia - she, pencil - it etc., They enjoyed as well as learnt that pronouns are used instead of a noun.

Kung Fu Punctuation actions - Children learnt different Kung Fu moves for each punctuation mark. This was so much fun as they enjoyed and learnt the names of various punctuation marks like full stop, Capital letters, Question Mark, comma etc.

Subtraction is a fundamental math concept that builds upon addition skills. In grade 1, students begin to learn subtraction as a way to find the difference between two numbers. They demonstrated a strong understanding of subtraction using concrete objects, such as straws, pastas, beads, gems etc. They showed a good grasp of using number lines to subtract single-digit numbers. They understood the concept of moving backwards on the number line to find the answer. They also enjoyed the story sums that were created on spot by the children themselves for better understanding of using subtraction in their daily life.

















<u>Food We Eat-</u>Children made some amazing and delicious food charts where they had to stick pictures of some special food along with the ingredients. This activity was an extended learning from the lesson 'Food We Eat.'

<u>Water In Our Lives -</u> To create awareness among students about the importance of water conservation the students of grade 1 made posters on the topic - 'Save Water'. Students created posters using various materials, illustrating their ideas and slogans. The finished posters were displayed in the classroom, and students explained their work to their peers. Students created eye-catching posters with effective slogans, such as "Save Water, Save Life", "Turn Off the Tap, Save the Planet", "There is no Planet B" etc., Children also learnt the different sources, uses and properties of water through various activities in class.

<u>Houses Around Us -</u> Students showed enthusiasm and curiosity about the different types of houses when they were introduced to a new topic in EVS - 'My House'. They demonstrated their understanding of basic house features and shapes when they made a booklet on 'Houses Around Us'. The activity encouraged fine motor skills, creativity, and self-expression.






Independence Day Special Assembly:
