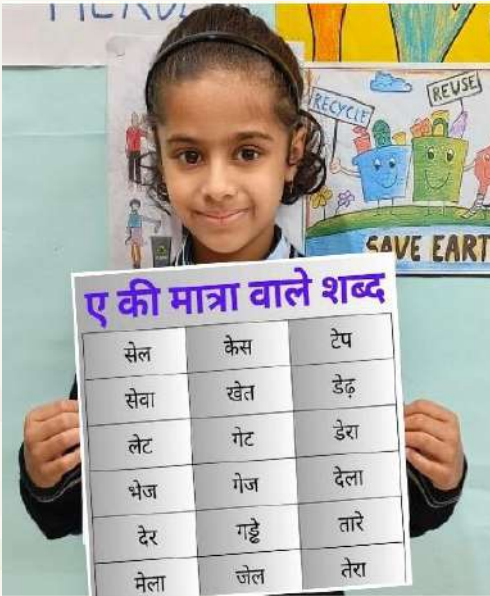
ಬಣ್ಣಗಳ ಪರಿಚಯ

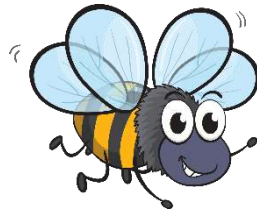
