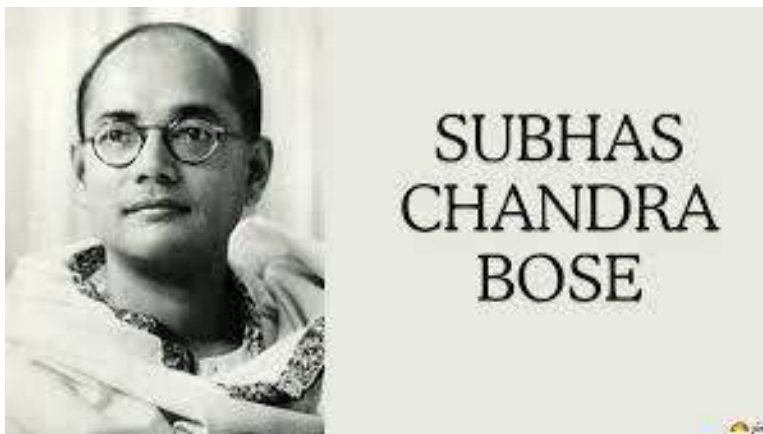
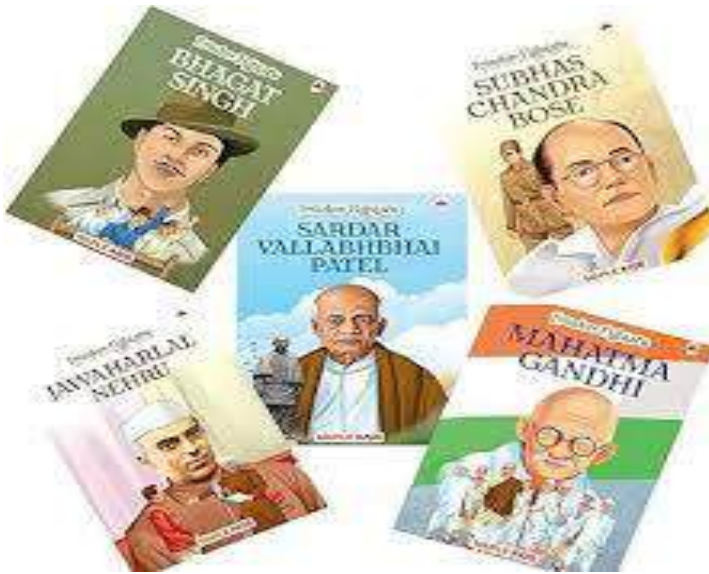

**Topic... Sensational Seasons in Tricolour.**

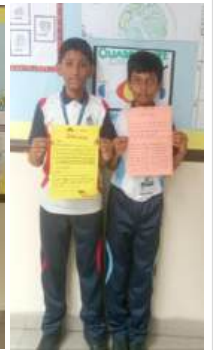
