## Montessori



Beginning at an early age, Montessori nurtures order, concentration, and independence. Intentional classroom design, materials, and daily routines support the student's ability to educate one's self, and to think about what one is learning. Exercises of practical life like how to wash their hands, cylinder blocks, number rods with number cards were introduced to students. Developing life skills at an early stage enhances strong foundation for the future.
