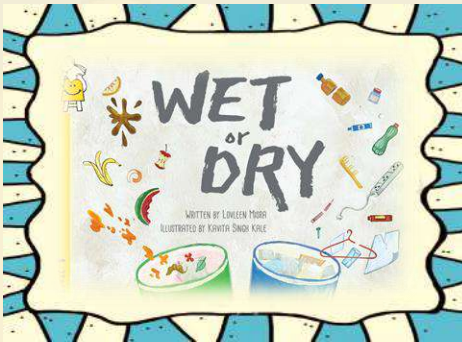

Title – ‘Wet Or Dry’

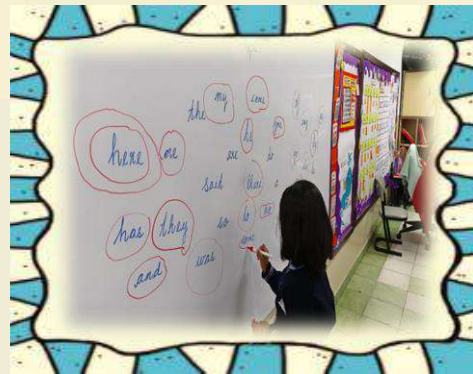

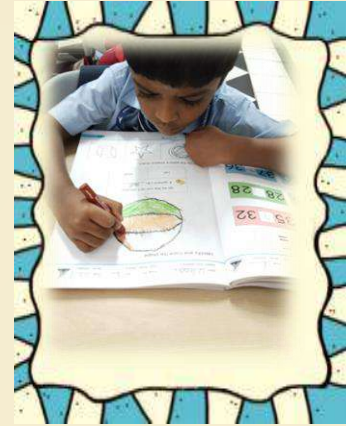

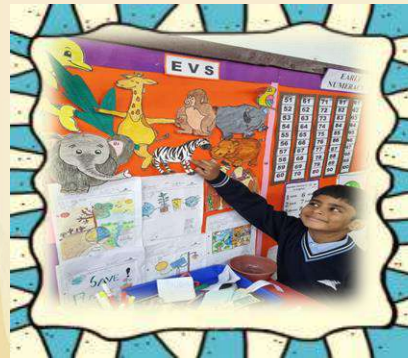

In the Montessori curriculum, learning to fold napkins is a practical life activity that helps children develop skills such as:

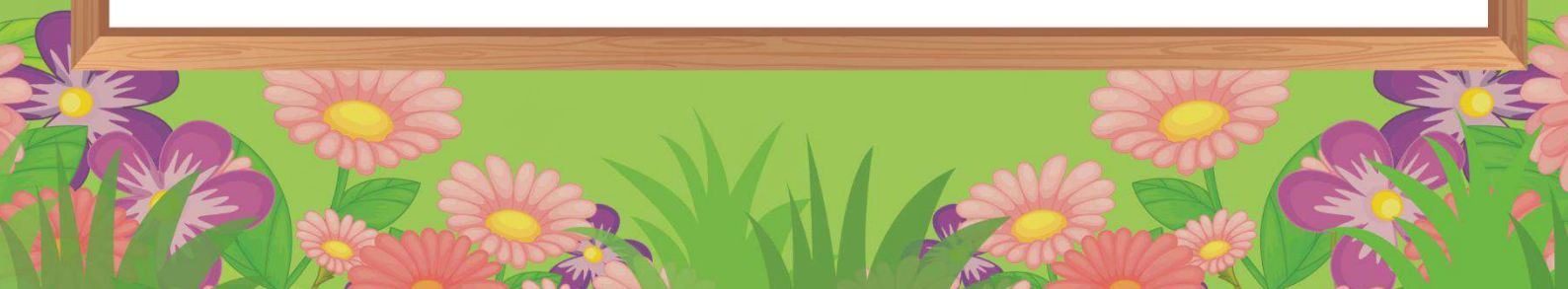
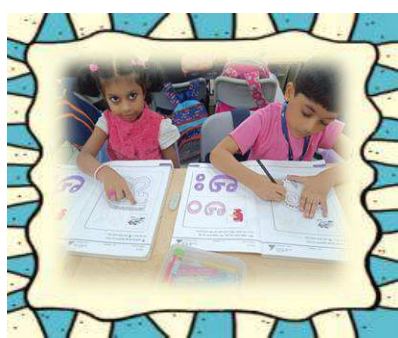
Fine motor skills: Folding napkins helps children develop finger muscle control.
