




Action Words -Identifying and naming the action words (e.g., run, jump, read) was introduced to the students of grade 1 in the month of October. They were able to recognize the action words in sentences, rhymes, poems etc. They could act out an action words, use gestures and facial expressions to convey action words. The students played the game of 'Simon Says' where the teachers called out different fun actions like crawl on the floor, jump like a kangaroo, flap your arms like a penguin and so on. This activity not only developed vocabulary and language skills but also enhanced reading and writing abilities.

Numbers Upto 100 - Place value is an important Math concept for students of grade1. One way to help students understand place value is to use manipulatives to show the value of each digit. The teacher modelled the place value of a number using some straws, thus the students could make relate numbers and place values. This activity helped students identify the place value and have a deeper understanding of Tens and Ones. They also learnt to represent the numbers on the abacus. They were able to bead the abacus for the given numbers upto 100.

<u>Our Clothes</u> - Students of grade 1 were introduced to the chapter, 'Our Clothes' in the month of October. They learnt this through several activities like mystery bag, collage, folding clothes etc. They brought different pieces of cloth like cotton, silk, rayon, jute etc. They spoke about the different seasons and occasions when we wear silk, cotton or wollen clothes. They learnt to make a collage by using pieces of cloth and desining a dress of their choice in class. They brought T-shirts to school for an activity to model the technique of folding and keep them neatly after wash.

<u>Air around us</u> – Students learnt that air occupies space by performing a simple experiment of blowing air in a balloon and releasing the air from the balloon. They observed that the size of the balloons increased when air was blown, decreased when the air came out of the balloon. They also enjoyed blowing bubbles, flying paper planes and paper boats in class along with their friends.















The students of grade 1 were introduced the letters क to ड. Students were able to identify and form the letters. They were also able to relate the objects with letter क to घ.

The students did vocal warm up exercises and solfege practice. Students had a recap session for all the songs that were taught from June month including the School prayer, School and National Anthem. Teaching small children the concept of line forms drawing develops fine motor skills, hand-eye coordination, spatial awareness and visual processing. The students of grade 1 were taught to use this concept when they had to draw a scenery and use lines as a pattern to enhance their drawing.
