LAR – Verbs (Doing Words/ Action words) is the most important part of a sentence. Verbs are very important for language development because they allow children to start making sentences early. Verb Activities are a fun way to learn about "Parts of Speech." We ensure that proper use of action words can do wonders in terms of enhancing children's vocabulary. "Guess the Verbs" activity was organised for the learners. Children picked the slips and acted out the action words written therein and enjoyed making sentences with the given action words. The central idea was to make the students know the verbs and their uses.









Math

Math: Subtraction up to 1000, with or without regrouping, is a fundamental math concept that builds upon students' understanding of place value and numerical relationships. This operation involves finding the difference between two numbers, either by counting down or using base-ten blocks to represent hundreds, tens, and ones. Subtraction of 3- digit numbers with and without regrouping of large numbers in columns with multiple regroupings were practiced during the month of October, which emphasis on practicing the regrouping using subtraction and discussing the clues and terms of subtraction.









EVS: EVS - Health and Hygiene

Students learnt about the importance of being healthy and the habits which contribute towards making us healthy like - Eating healthy foods, Daily Exercise, taking proper rest. Students learnt that hygiene also plays an important role in keeping us healthy. Taking a bath daily, brushing our teeth twice a day, washing hands before and after eating, keeping our surroundings clean are few ways to follow hygiene in our daily life.


