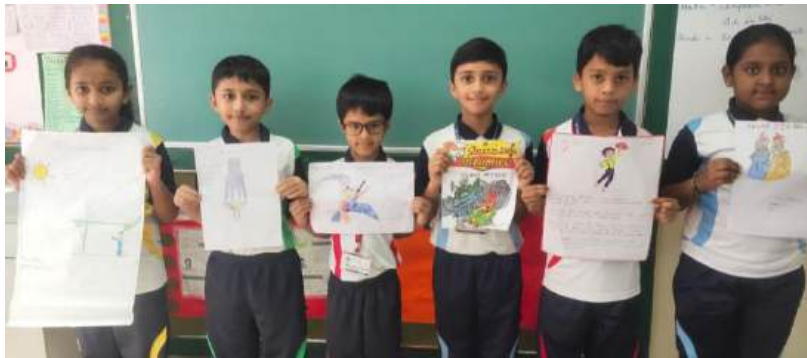
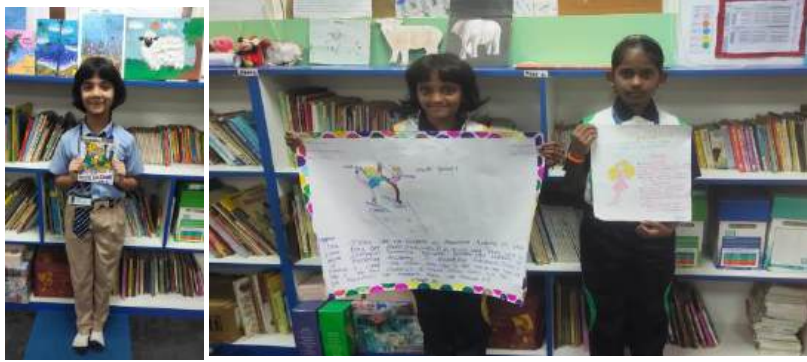

Students introduced themselves and there by demonstrated social skills by using descriptive words vocabulary in self-introduction.

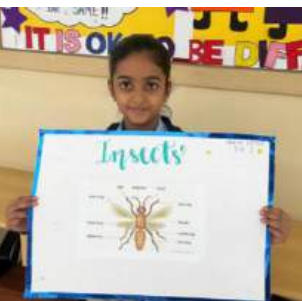
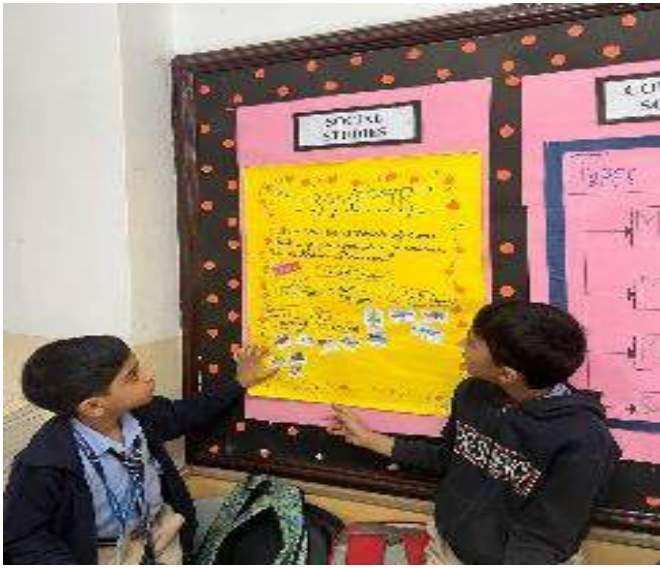
Students also listened to a motivational speech by Dr. Abdul Kalam.
